



CORON ISLAND TOUR

Be enchanted by the beauty of the picturesque Cayangan Lake or take a dip at the invigorating Maquinit Hot Springs as our whole day tour brings you to Coron Town and Coron Island.

Inclusions: Roundtrip land and boat transfers, tour guide, entrance fees, mineral water.

Options for lunch:

For guests with full/half board meal packages, lunch will be served on site. List of complete meal selections are available at the Front Desk. For guests without meal packages, meals may be chosen from the restaurant's a la carte menu or may avail of the lunch package at PHP 1,000 nett per person.

Options for exclusive tour:

Additional PHP 2,000 / group for the exclusivity fee

Child Rate (5 - 10 years old) PHP 2,260 / child.

Rates are inclusive of applicable tax and service charge.

How to get there

A boat will take you from Club Paradise to Decalachao Bridge or Maricaban Village. From there, you will board an air conditioned van to Coron Town. From Coron Town, a boat will take you to the Twin Lagoons and to the Cayangan Lake. You will later take your lunch on the boat or at the beachfront of a nearby island. After lunch, you will proceed to Siete Pecados Marine Park then end the day with an invigorating dip in the Maquinit Hot Springs. Should you prefer to make changes in the itinerary, kindly advise the Guest Services Officer prior to departure.

Schedule of Trips

The boat for the Coron Tour leaves at 7:00 or 8:00am. Kindly confirm your reservation with the Front Desk a day before and advise them if you wish to request for a wake up call. The Coron Island Tour is a whole day tour. You will be back at Club Paradise around 4:00 - 5:00pm.

What to Wear and Bring

Shorts, shirts, hats, sun glasses are ideal. We also recommend rash guards and aqua shoes to make your excursion more comfortable. Don't forget to bring your swimming and snorkeling gears. Sun block and mosquito repellent is a must. You may also bring cash for souvenir shopping.

What to Expect

During the rainy season, the pathways to the Cayangan Lake may be slippery and the hills leading to it quite steep. But we assure you that the scenes are all beautiful and breathtaking!



CALAUTIT SAFARI TOUR

Explore the Philippines' wildlife sanctuary - Calauit Island. An ideal home to various species of exotic African and endemic Palawan flora and fauna. Hundreds of animals such as a variety of birds, giraffes, elans, waterbucks, Calamian deers, monkeys, fresh water crocodiles, zebras and bushbucks freely roam the island. A tropical safari that should not be missed!

per person (minimum of 4 adults)

Inclusions:

Tour guide, Calauit Guide, roundtrip boat transfers, use of tour jeep, park entrance, snacks, one round of drinks, and short lecture about the sanctuary.

Rates are inclusive of applicable tax and service charge.

Child Rate (3- 11 years old) is half the price of the prevailing rate.

Tours are subject to prevailing sea and weather conditions.

How to get there

Calauit Island is one hour and a half away from Club Paradise. During low tide, a small boat will be used to fetch guests a few meters from the shore.

Schedule of Trips

Morning trip is scheduled at 7:00am and breakfast will be served before you leave. Kindly advise the Front Desk if you wish to request for a wake up call. Afternoon trips are scheduled at 1:00pm. The whole trip takes around 5-6 hours, depending on sea conditions.

Minimum per trip is 4 persons. The jeep can accommodate up to 6 or 8 persons.

What to Wear and Bring

Wear light clothing, sunblock, hat or cap and a pair of slippers / shoes. Do not forget to bring your cameras and some cash for souvenir shopping at their gift shop. You can also bring additional snacks.

What to Expect

This is open wildlife sanctuary and the animals are roaming freely. There may be times some animals will be hiding so you won't get to see them. Since most of the animals are still wild, wandering and going near them without permission from the Calauit guide is strictly prohibited.

Important Notice

The Calauit Office is closed every Saturday and Sunday. All tours desired to be taken on Saturday, Sunday or Monday morning should be reserved on Friday afternoon. All reservations received later than Friday afternoon will be confirmed Monday morning at 10:00am.



ISLAND HOPPING

Hop into our boats as we bring you to these 3 islands: Malpagalen Island, Dimalanta, and Diatoy.

HALF DAY

Inclusions:

Snacks and one round of drinks, tour guide, and roundtrip boat transfers.

Options for lunch:

Lunch will be packed if meals are prepaid or included in your package. If not, packed lunch will be charged to your room. Meal selections are available at Ocean Restaurant.

Children (3 - 11 years old) is half the price of the prevailing rate.

Tours are subject to prevailing sea and weather conditions. Rates are inclusive of applicable tax and service charge.

How to get there

These three islands can be reached by boat: Malpagalen Island is 15 minutes away; Dimalanta is 40 minutes away; while Diatoy Island is 45 minutes away.

A choice of half-day tour (maximum of 4 hours) and a whole day tour (up to 6 hrs) is available. Should you opt to have your lunch on one of the islands, please inform the Front Desk beforehand. Kindly note that a minimum of 2 persons is required per trip.

What to Wear and Bring

Wear light clothing, hat, sunglasses and sunblock. We also recommend rash guards and aqua shoes to make your excursion more comfortable. You may also bring your swimming and snorkeling gear.

What to Expect

- In Malpagalen Island, there is no natural shade but we will bring beach umbrellas for you. This islet has a small sand bar and rocky cliffs on its left side.
- Isla Walang Tao and Dimalanta Island have many tall corals, which are quite splendid! Boats will not be able to dock on the shore so guests have to swim or use a small boat to get to the island.
- Trees are quite bountiful in Diatoy Island. The waves going to this island can be rough.



ISLAND ESCAPADE

Spend some time with friends or loved ones in a beautiful uninhabited island. Choose your island paradise.

Inclusions:

Snacks and one round of drinks, tour guide and boat transfers.

Options for lunch:

Lunch will be packed if meals are prepaid or included in your package. If not, packed lunch will be charged to your room. Meal selections are available at Ocean Restaurant.

Child Rate (3 - 11 years old) is half the price of the prevailing rate.

Tours are subject to prevailing sea and weather conditions.
Rates are inclusive of applicable tax and service charge.

How to get there

Three islands can be reached by boat from Club Paradise, Dimakya Island: Malpagalen Island is 15 minutes away; Dimalanta is 40 minutes away and Diatoy Island is 45 minutes away.

Kindly advise the Front Desk on the particular island you wish to visit and whether you would like to travel with other guests, or with a snorkeling guide. If you wish for privacy, we will leave you with beach mats, umbrellas, towels, and packed lunch or snacks then pick you up after the tour. Let us know the time you wish to be picked up.

What to Wear and Bring

Wear light clothing and sunblock. You may also bring your swimming and snorkeling gear.

What to Expect

- In Malpagalen Island, there is no natural shade but we will bring beach umbrellas for you. This islet has a small sand bar and rocky cliffs on its left side.
- Dimalanta Island have many tall corals, which are quite splendid! Boats will not be able to dock on the shore so guests have to swim or use a small boat to get to the island.
- Trees are quite bountiful in Diatoy Island. The waves going to this island can be rough.

We highly recommend snorkeling in these islands. However, diving without the company of a dive master as well as fishing in these areas are strictly prohibited. Minimum of 2 persons per trip is required. This half day tour will approximately take 4 hours.



SPLISH, SPLASH!

Take a day trip to Diatoy Island where you can explore the amazing diversity of marine life, delight in a Boodle Fight lunch, and enjoy an exciting speed-induced Banana boat ride with your family and friends.

- * Additional fee of PHP 1,100 nett per person for Boodle Fight lunch is available for guests who availed of the room and breakfast package only.

How to get there

Diatoy Island is 45 minutes away from Club Paradise. You will be brought there via the Club Paradise boat. This half day tour will approximately take 4 hours.

What to Wear and Bring

- Swimwear, preferably with a rash guard and aqua shoes.
- Please remove your jewelries and do not bring electronic gadgets during the banana boat ride
- For safety reasons, small children are discouraged to take the banana boat ride but if they need to travel with the group, our Tour guide can watch over them at the picnic area.



BOTTOM FISHING

Prepare your fishing gear as you try your luck in bottom fishing. The best part of this trip? You can have your catch cooked for lunch or dinner!

Inclusions:

Fishing handline, bait, tour guide and roundtrip boat transfers.

Rates are inclusive of applicable tax and service charge.

Children (3 - 11 years old) shall be charged half the price of the prevailing rate.

Tours are subject to prevailing sea and weather conditions.

Schedule of Trips

The Morning trip is scheduled at 6:00am and the afternoon trip at 2:00pm. The entire trip takes about 3-4 hours, depending on sea conditions. Minimum of 2 persons per trip is required.

What to Wear and Bring

Wear light clothing and sunblock. If you have your own fishing rod, you may take that with you as well.

What to Expect

The boat will stop at designated areas away from Club Paradise where fish of various kinds are abundant. However, you will never know what the sea will provide, so be patient. A small reminder: please return the the small fishes back to the sea.

Should you wish to sashimi your fresh catch right on the boat, please inform the Front Desk so we can pack some condiments for you. But if you wish to have it cooked at our Kitchen, please inform your guide.
